
Our **3-year BSc Nursing programme** enables the student to obtain professional qualifications in accordance with European Union requirements in medical sciences and nursing practice.

LONG-CYCLE STUDIES

Physiotherapy is a medical profession providing healthcare services with the aim of restoring and maintaining proper body functionality and mobility. In many settings, physiotherapy is combined with other medical services, aimed at prevention and treatment of illnesses.

Our **5-year Master's degree in Physiotherapy programme** has been developed with full reference to recent changes in health service provisions in EU and within education standards and directives of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy (WCPT). The future physiotherapists are taught by experienced health care professionals who are committed to ensure that students will develop the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values which they will then use to identify patient problems, set treatment goals, select and safely apply appropriate evidence-based physiotherapy treatment.

Our Physiotherapy programme provides an innovative, student-centred and employability-focused curriculum. Students gain the knowledge of the most up-to-date forms of manual therapy (Kinesiotaping), neuro-developmental techniques (PNF and NDT-Bobath), physical medicine, functional diagnosis and rehabilitation programming. Graduates are prepared to work in scientific research institutions and are eligible to apply for a professional speciality in physiotherapy as well as PhD studies. Apart from the compulsory study programme, students have the opportunity to attend voluntary supplemental certified courses.

PLACEMENT

The programme includes clinical placements integrated throughout the course. Students are obliged to undergo practical training under the supervision of highly-qualifed physiotherapists in a range of clinical facilities located in Lublin or individually chosen countries.

Pursuant to the new act on the profession of physiotherapist, § 17, section 1 of the regulation of Minister of Science and Higher Education of 26 September 2016, on conditions of studies, **Physiotherapy** will be offered only as long-cycle master degree studies among other programmes like: Medicine, Medicine and Dentistry, Laboratory Medicine, Pharmacy, Veterinary Medicine, Law, and Canon Law

Students who want to work as physio- therapists in Poland and start their 5-year long-cycle Master degree programme in Physiotherapy after 1 October 2017, are obliged to complete 6-month practical training after graduation, take National Specialization Exam for Physiotherapists, and register themselves in the National Physiotherapy Registry.





The growth of world trade and technological progress as well as global capital flow across national boundaries adds to the competitive pressure on companies. The programme prepares students to understand and face those challenges.

Our **3-year Bachelor's degree in International Business Management programme** aims to educate and train international business professionals who want to work successfully as economists and managers in any country or culture and combine one's knowledge of business processes with interpersonal relations with partners from diverse cultures. The hands-on and case-based teaching approach provides each graduate with a comprehensive knowledge of business and economics, including the fields of marketing, sales, finance, quality, and management, as well as financials, human and physical resources.

Managerial Economics – contemporary economic environment requires from specialists (managers) a profound understanding of the changes affecting individual economic entities. This speciality teaches management at the level of micro and macroeconomy and provides an explanation regarding the current happenings in economy. Graduates of the managerial economics speciality are prepared to perform functions of managers at various decision-making levels.

International Business – this speciality is mainly focused on learning about reasons and consequences of international exchange of goods and services, investment flow, migration, as well as the manner of functioning of multinational companies and integration groups. Globalisation, Poland's membership in the European Union, development of economic relations with countries of Eastern Europe and activity of international investors in Poland are the most important factors that are necessary to understand the functioning of a fully open economy.

English philology is a discipline devoted to history and culture of English-speaking countries. Intensive development of language skills is combined with engaging studies in the fields of literature, linguistics, history and media.

Our 3-year Bachelor's degree in English Philology programme is aimed at students who apart from learning the English language, are also interested in everything that is connected with English-speaking culture and lifestyle, for example theatre, poetry, but also films, TV series and press. Therefore, the studies should on no account be treated as an intensive language cour- se. The course ends with a final language exam (level B2). The exam will be recognised as a proof of English language competence required for admissions at VPU.

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
