

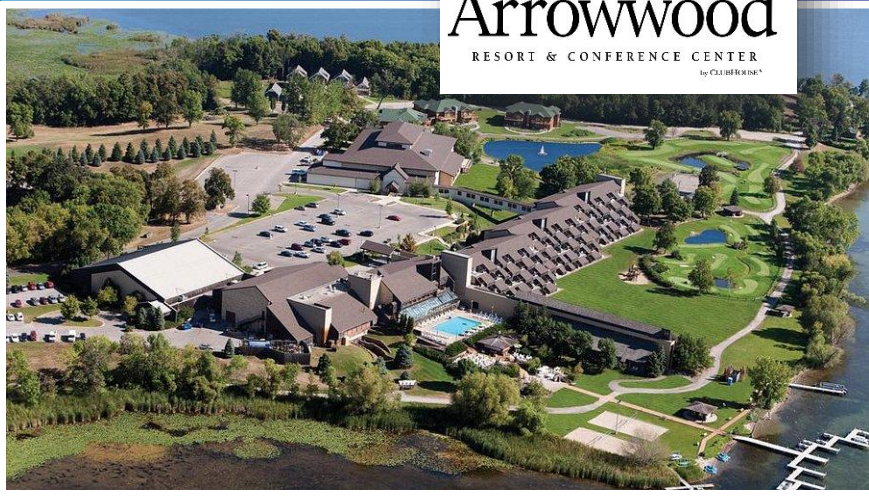

So no matter the time of year (including holidays!), Arrowwood Resort is the perfect getaway for families, friends, groups, retreats, conventions, and more.



As an Arrowwood Resort F&B Team Member, you will do tasks of **Kitchen Helper/Dishwasher**, **Cook**, and **Snack Bar Attendant** all within the job title of F&B Team Member. As a kitchen helper, participants will be assisting with preparing food and dishes that need to be served. You will be responsible for setting up the kitchen line, prepping for the meal period and events, bring stock from store room and daily inventory. Participants will be washing dishes either using a dishwasher to clean plate and glassware or cleaning pots and pans by hand. Additionally, participant will be responsible for maintaining a clean workstation, assisting kitchen areas where required and keeping the kitchen clean. As a line cook, participants will be responsible for much of the food production in the kitchen and will assist the cook(s) to prepare dishes. Each line cook is typically assigned a place on the assembly line, such as the grill, stove or vegetable prep area, and is responsible for cooking that specific portion of the meal. Job duties include assisting prep cooks in cutting, precooking and marinating food as well as keeping the kitchen clean and operational. As a food counter attendant, participants will be preparing and serving customers' food and drinks. Depending on the items served at the counter, their food counter attendant will be responsible for preparation of the food. Participants will also take orders from the customers, prepare the items, and serve the items based on customers' needs. Duties also involve handling the financial transactions related to the food and drink purchases and delivering orders to the kitchen when applicable. Participant may also be responsible for tracking and handling inventory for the counter.

HOUSING & TRANSPORTATION

Host Employer assists with housing, and it will be a Trailer Home.

- **Housing** is not required for the job placement but is recommended by your Host Employer.
- **Participants** may be required to sign a housing agreement. By signing the program information guide and/or housing agreement, participants are agreeing to stay at housing that has been pre-arranged for the entire length of the agreement.
- **You** will be required to make initial housing payments upon arrival, which could include security deposit & setup fee.
- **Any** damage to the property will result in participants paying the cost as determined by the housing management.
- **Detailed** housing arrangement will be disclosed by GEC prior to arrivals.
- **Housing** cost is approximately \$110 per week and paid and \$220 biweekly via payroll deduction.
- **Your** Host Employer will assign rooming lists based on arrival/departure dates and specific roommates may not be guaranteed.
- **When** offered the placement, by signing the Work Agreement and Program Information Guide, exchange visitors assume responsibility to read the housing rules and abide by all terms and conditions.
- **Various** Transportation options available and might include Public Transportation, Taxi/Shuttle Service, & Ride Share (Uber/Lyft).

When you have been selected, please carefully review your final placement details in your Program Information Guide. It is your responsibility to read and understand your placement details BEFORE signing your work agreement and Program Information Guide acknowledgment form that indicates the acceptance of your placement details.

While the work component of your program will provide some funds throughout your program, your wages earned in the U.S. may not cover all of your living expenses or the costs associated with expenses to come to the U.S. Use the budget section in your Participant Handbook to ensure you have enough funds.
