


# Summer Work Travel 2026

We're only two hours down the interstate from the Twin Cities (Minneapolis and St. Paul), and about 90 minutes from Fargo, ND. Once you're here, you'll find plenty to explore: try the Carlos Creek Winery, the Minnesota Lakes Maritime Museum, and other local hotspots! So no matter the time of year (including holidays!), Arrowwood Resort is the perfect getaway for families, friends, groups, retreats, conventions, and more.

As an Arrowwood Resort Rooms Team Member, you will do tasks of **Houseperson/Porter**, **Housekeeper**, and **Laundry Attendant**. As a houseperson, participants will keep the general appearance of the facility in clean, functional working order. This includes being accessible to customers and greeting & responding to guests in a friendly & courteous manner. Keep the lobby, hallways & restrooms clean, assist in setting up rooms for catering events, and restock cleaning/general supplies. Houseperson assists with laundry, cleaning & restocking pool areas, beach & outdoor recreational areas. Duties also include delivering firewood & guest supplies & handling small maintenance related calls. In the housekeeper role, participants are responsible for cleaning guest rooms and property common areas. Job duties include picking up after a guest, preparing fresh linens, making beds, dusting furniture & fixtures, washing floors, vacuuming carpeted areas, emptying trash cans, cleaning windows, cleaning the bathroom & toilet, keeping the guest rooms stocked with accessories, and keeping the bathrooms stocked with supplies. Laundry Attendants responsibilities include sorting, washing, drying, folding, and ironing clothes & linens according to fabric types & care instructions. Participants will be responsible for operating laundry machines safely & efficiently, treating stains, and inspecting items for cleanliness & damage. Maintaining the cleanliness of the laundry area, keeping equipment in good working condition, and following all safety and hygiene standards are essential parts of the role. Laundry Attendants must also ensure timely completion of tasks & may be required to assist with inventory management.

### HOUSING & TRANSPORTATION

*Host Employer assists with housing, and it will be a Trailer Home.*

- **Housing** is not required for the job placement but is recommended by your Host Employer.
- **Participants** may be required to sign a housing agreement. By signing the program information guide and/or housing agreement, participants are agreeing to stay at housing that has been pre-arranged for the entire length of the agreement.
- **You** will be required to make initial housing payments upon arrival, which could include security deposit & setup fee.
- **Any** damage to the property will result in participants paying the cost as determined by the housing management.
- **Detailed** housing arrangement will be disclosed by GEC prior to arrivals.
- **Housing** cost is approximately \$110 per week and paid and \$220 biweekly via payroll deduction.
- **Your** Host Employer will assign rooming lists based on arrival/departure dates and specific roommates may not be guaranteed.
- **When** offered the placement, by signing the Work Agreement and Program Information Guide, exchange visitors assume responsibility to read the housing rules and abide by all terms and conditions.
- **Various** Transportation options available and might include Public Transportation, Taxi/Shuttle Service, & Ride Share (Uber/Lyft).
